***Saving God* Nominated for *Time for Peace* Award; Ving Rhames Nominated for Best Actor**

November 12, 2008. *SAVING GOD*, a new DVD release by Cloud Ten Pictures and Clear Entertainment, has been nominated for the 2008/2009 Time for Peace Film Awards. Star **Ving Rhames** has been nominated for the 2008/2009 Time for Peace Actor Award for his “exceptional performance as Reverend Armstrong Cane.”

The Time for Peace Film and Music Awards were created in 1994 to honor films that celebrate values that speak to the rights and dignity of men and women alike. The nominating panel is comprised of film and music industry professionals, and the winners are selected by a jury composed of 25 UNITED NATIONS ambassadors. The Time For Peace Awards draw attention to stories where the protagonists offer constructive answers to questions that all people ask themselves, promote methods by which civilization can function more positively and *learn how to transform the world*. The nominated films can serve as therapeutic means to direct violent behavior toward creative and constructive resolutions.

The highly prestigious award has previously been presented to filmmakers such as **Steven Spielberg** for *SCHINDLER'S LIST* and later *AMISTAD*, Michael Radford for *IL POSTINO*, Scott Hicks for *SHINE* and Michael Winterbottom for *A MIGHTY HEART*. Previous actor winners include **Robin Williams** for his performance as Sean McGuire in *GOOD WILL HUNTING* and actress **Hilary Swank** for her performance as Erin Gr uwell in *FREEDOM WRITERS*.

SAVING GOD tells the story of Armstrong Cane (Ving Rhames, *MISSION IMPOSSIBLE*) a reformed ex-con, who returns from prison to preach at his father's former church, only to find the neighborhood overtaken by a ruthless drug dealer (Dean McDermott, “Tori and Dean Inn Love”) and the congregation in crisis. Many are seeking solace from a slick preacher (Ricardo Chavira, “Desperate Housewives”) and abandoning those who need the most help. As Cane works to save the community he left behind, to save his young parishioners from the dangerous draw of the streets and to save himself from the demons of his violent past, he faces the ultimate question: *Who will save God for the souls who have lost Him?*

SAVING GOD is a co-production by Canadian-based Cloud Ten Pictures and Clear Entertainment. The picture has also been endorsed by the family-focused film review boards at the Dove Foundation and the American Family Association.
